South Bend International Airport Notice of Intent to File a PFC Application November 3, 2021

The St. Joseph County Airport Authority, Sponsor of the South Bend International Airport (SBN), is planning to file an application with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to impose and use a Passenger Facility Charge (PFC) to fund capital improvement projects. This notice is being issued to meet PFC application filing requirements set forth in 14 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) § 158.24. The proposed charge is \$4.50 per enplaned passenger and is estimated to be effective July 1, 2029 with an estimated expiration occurring on September 30, 2030. The total revenue to be collected and used by SBN at the end of the collection period is \$1,511,817 and will fund:

Project	Requested PFC Charge	Total Requested Revenue
Acquire Snow Removal Equipment (SRE) – Two (2) Multi-Function Units		
- This project is the purchase of two (2) multi-function SRE vehicles each with a MB5 Chassis carrier vehicle, a 24-foot plow, and a 22-foot rotary broom with high velocity air. SBN has an insufficient number of SRE, many of which have exceeded their service life and require extensive maintenance to remove snow and ice from priority airfield surfaces. SBN has 12 vehicles for snow removal and based on annual amount of snowfall and area of priority airfield surfaces a determination with the FAA was made that the fleet size should be 24 vehicles. The purchase of two (2) multi-function SREs will allow for the more timely and efficient removal of snow and ice, reducing operational stresses on existing SRE.	\$4.50	\$1,491,480
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PFC Application Preparation Expenses		
- This project is the expenses associated with the preparation of PFC application 2021-05-C-00-SBN. Projects comprising the PFC application are: 1) Acquire two (2) SRE multi-function units and 2) the total cost of the professional services contract to prepare PFC application 2021-05-C-00-SBN. This project is eligible to be funded with PFCs in accordance with FAR Part 158 and FAA Order 5500.1, Passenger Facility Charge.	\$4.50	\$20,337
